Dreaming Ourselves into Being : Field-Relational Dreamwork 2 With Sally Denham- Vaughan

This workshop is a follow on from our successful first dream workshop in November. It is open to counsellors, psychotherapists, coaches and anyone interested in learning more about how dreams might inform our sense of who we are now and who we have potential to become. It is also useful as a refresher for more experienced practitioners who want to bring a relational, creative and process orientated approach to their work. The theoretical basis of the approach will be briefly presented, but the teaching will be through experiential learning and discussion of pieces of work. There are opportunities for live supervision and small group practice if desired.

In view of this it would be helpful if participants can arrive prepared to work on their own dream material and that of others in the group.

The aim is both personal development and to build confidence and skills in working with dreams in a contemporary field-relational approach.

We will pay attention to forming a supportive group where we can experiment with the possibilities originating in dreams. No one will be expected to do anything they don't want to do and explicit attention will be paid to creating a safe group contract. The workshop is appropriate to those who attended the November workshop with Sally and those who are new to the approach.

Sally is a Gestalt Psychotherapist, Supervisor, Trainer, Accredited Organisational Practitioner, Coach, writer and editorial advisor to the British Gestalt Journal. She has been a Co-Director of both psychotherapy and organisational change programmes in the UK. Originally trained as a Clinical and Counselling Psychologist, Sally worked for many years in the British National Health Service clinically leading and managing a range of services provided to Adults with Mental Health Problems. She is a Faculty member of the International Gestalt in Organisations programme based in Turin, Italy, Academic Adviser on the Doctoral Programme at Metanoia Institute in London, International Faculty Associate at Pacific Gestalt Institute, International Board Adviser at The Relational Center, Los Angeles and Co-founder of Relational Change, (www.relationalchange.org), an international organisation committed to promoting developments in Relational theory and practice.
