This 'hands on' arts training caters for counsellors, psychotherapists



and other professionals working with children. Incorporating the arts in therapy with children offers an 'experience near' vehicle for self-expression that aids contactful exploration of issues, fosters resilience and enhances wellbeing. Rooted in Gestalt therapy theory the course draws inspiration from the projective arts

approach of Dr. Violet Oaklander (ref. Windows to our Children) as well as ideas from Attachment and Systemic theories. It will also interest those wishing to explore their own relationship with creativity/ play as the course gives a good grounding in how to incorporate working with various materials and modalities (clay, drawing, sand tray, music-

making, puppets, story- making etc) into your practice, together with theoretical input and discussion.





A Continued Professional Development certificate will be available on completion of the Course. Amounting to 90 hours in total.

You may also be interested in continuing CYP training, of which this Course will provide foundation learning towards a European Certificate which is parable to a UK Postgraduate Diploma accredited Course. It is possible to attend discreet workshops.
